ABOUT COMPETITION COMMISSION OF INDIA

CCI is a regulatory body established by the Government of India with effect from 14th October 2003. The duty of the Commission is to carry out the objectives enumerated under the Competition Act, 2002 that prohibits anti-competitive agreements, abuse of dominant position by enterprises and regulates combinations (acquisition, acquiring of control, and M&A), which cause or are likely to cause an appreciable adverse effect on competition within India. The mandate of the CCI includes eliminating practices having an adverse effect on competition; inspiring businesses to be fair, competitive, and innovative; promoting and sustenance of competition; protection of the interests of consumers and ensuring freedom of trade in the markets of India. The Commission engages in wide-ranging advocacy programmes like conducting training sessions for judicial officers and district judges, organizing panel discussions and conferences on issues in competition law, offering internship opportunities to students, and also organizing national level competitions

ABOUT ILNU NATIONAL MOOT COURT COMPETITION

The Institute of Law, Nirma University - National Moot Court Competition (IL-NMCC) is an initiative of the student community at ILNU with an aim to bring together students from different regions to come together, interact, compete and challenge their skills as future legal practitioners.
